Absences

- 9 unexcused absences per semester. The absence will not be excused until appropriate written documentation is provided by a licensed physician or legal agency within 5 school days after returning to school (i.e. student is absent on a Monday, must present written documentation the following Monday).
- > Religious holidays will qualify as excused absences, if they meet ALL of the following criteria:
 - a. It must be recognized by the State of New Jersey (Please view the link on the high school's website for approved holidays.)
 - b. A note must be provided at least 3 school days prior to the holiday
- Students who exceed the limit of 9 unexcused absences per semester will be placed on a "non-credit" status and restricted from all Co-Curricular and Extracurricular Activities (ALL after school activities). These restrictions include sports, field trips, clubs, prom, and/or Graduation Ceremonies for Seniors.
- > Students must attend Credit Completion make-up sessions for each unexcused day that exceeds the limit of **9 unexcused absences for the semester** in order to be removed from the Restriction List.
