 Whereas, Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-5.2, each school district must establish policies and strategies in order to minimize the cost of professional services. Whatever strategy the Board of Education employs, it must be "practical" and "cost effective".

THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Pleasantville Board of Education that in order to comply with the Pleasantville Board of Education Policy 0174, the following process shall be followed:

- Step 1. All errors and omissions claims must be reported/forwarded to the Office of the Business Administrator/Board Secretary.
- Step 2. The Business Administrator/Board Secretary will immediately log claims and then forward the claims immediately to the Insurance Carrier. All logged claims are to be housed in a secure file cabinet within the business office.
- Step 3. If coverage or defense is denied *or limited in any manner* under the policy, the Insurance *carrier* must provide that denial of *said coverage* in writing to the Office of the Business Administrator/Board Secretary *with a copy to the Board of Education for their review*.
- Step 4. Upon receipt of the denial *or limitation of coverage from the Insurance Carrier* the Business Administrator/Board Secretary must *immediately notify the Board Solicitor of the need for a defense*.
- Step 5. Once the Insurance Carrier denies the claim, all uncovered matters or matters where the Insurance Carrier has placed limitations on coverage must be forwarded to the Board Solicitor unless otherwise determined through the appointment by the Board of Education of another law firm to represent its interests. It will be the responsibility of the Administration Office through the Superintendent of Schools and/or the Board Secretary or Assistant Board Secretary to ensure that said legal matters which include complaints in the Superior Court Law Division, for personal injury matters, Workers Compensation matters, civil rights matters, contract claims, challenges to bids, Notices of Tort Claims, Petitions of Appeal, increment withholdings, expulsions, and general advice be provided to the Board Solicitor.
- Step 6. The Board Solicitor is expected to attend all meetings of the Board of Education. Labor Counsel or other BOE assigned attorneys should attend those meetings where issues involving negotiations, grievances or matters involving the collective bargaining agreement need to be discussed *or unless requested by the Board of Education to attend said meetings*. Unless Labor Counsel or other BOE assigned Attorneys are needed for purposes of the open session, Labor Counsel or other BOE assigned attorneys will not be *compensated if they wish to* remain throughout the duration of the meeting unless requested to do so by the Board of Education.

- Step 7. The Administration shall provide monthly updates to the Board of Education as to the number of firms providing representation on behalf of the Board through New Jersey School Boards including the name of the case.
- Step 8. The Administration shall obtain written confirmation of receipt of forwarded legal issues that will to be addressed by the Board Solicitor or BOE assigned Attorney through the use of electronic mail. *The use of regular mail should also be used in the event e-mail is down or the attorney is on trial and has not had an opportunity to review e-mails.*
- Step 9. The Board Solicitor and Labor Counsel shall take all steps that are reasonable to protect the interests of the Board of Education. The Board of Education President shall maintain communication with the Superintendent and Board Solicitor and shall collectively compel updates from those representing the interest of the District when necessary to present reports to the Board of Education.
- Step 10. The Business Administrator/Board Secretary shall keep adequate records of discussions with the Board Solicitor's Office and or BOE assigned Counsel in order to ensure that billing of both is consistent with the requests for advice. The most efficient manner in which to do so is to follow up oral conversations with electronic mail. However, the administration must be careful not to reveal the substance of any privileged conversations in writing unless approved by Board Counsel. A brief summary of the need to contact Board Counsel should suffice.
