Whereas, the principal and interest on approved loans will be paid directly to the lending bank by the State of New Jersey;

**Now Therefore Be It Resolved** that the Board of Education of the City of Pleasantville in the County of Atlantic, New Jersey hereby authorizes the School Business Administrator/Board Secretary, or his designee, to submit the necessary application and supporting documentation to the Atlantic County Executive Superintendent to obtain funding in the amount of \$3,403,070.00 together with interest thereon, at the rate of

1.78 % to 2.6% per annum from Susquehanna Bank and TD Bank and authorizes the execution of a "State School Aid Application Note" with the lender to undertake the borrowing.

This resolution shall take effect immediately.]
