RESOLUTION

The Pleasantville Board of Education is committed to ensuring all students succeed academically and reach their full potential in life. In doing so, it is also committed to providing opportunities for and ensuring that all students (inclusive of English Language Learners and Special Education Students) meet the New Jersey Core Curriculum Content Standards and achieve academic and long-life success.

Prior to the motion and vote on the Curriculum & Instruction Agenda Items, Ms. Famularo expressed the need for the "attached" Summer Reading List of Books. Mr. Mulvihill passed out additional copies to the Board. Ms. Famularo opened conversation with the Board and administration (namely, Ms. Seymore, Ms. Griffin, Dr. Bailey, Ms. Jenkins-Smith, and Mrs. Graves) regarding whether or not the Summer Reading List/Books are accessible to the students. ms. Seymore said that when she was a teacher, as a rule, teachers assigned the books on the Summer Reading List, and if "Mary Browne" was not available in the library the student would have another book similar (alternate) to select. It was explained that the Pleasantville School District summer programs will have the list of books available to the students, the Pleasantville Public Library also has the Summer Reading List for support the students, the books can also be read online at home or utilizing the school computer as needed, free books are available at the end of the school year because librarians sometimes get a "two-for-one", some organizations donate books to the schools, in addition to "Boarders" having the books on their shelves per Ms. Jenkins-Smith. Ms. Famularo expressed that with our school budget of 91 million dollars, we should make the books for the Summer Reading List a priority.....if we don't buy the m the books, then, who will.....what about the parents that got laid off from the casinos....this is the most important thing that we can do for our kids.....nobody wanted to listen when I made the recommendation of KINDLES.....nobody wanted to do anything about it". After the motion and before the vote, Ms. Graham expressed that every year the Summer Reading Program/List is revised and given and the books are purchased...this year, these books are being purchased. So, what part am I missing?"
