Dear Pleasantville Board of Education,

In accordance with N.J.S.A. 18A:7A-55(b), the state monitor is given the responsibility to provide direct oversight of a board of education's business operations and personnel matters. The statute grants the state monitor the authority to override a chief school administrator's action and a vote by the board of education on any of the matters set forth in this subsection, except that all actions of the state monitor shall be subject to the education, labor and employment laws and regulations, including the "New Jersey Employer-Employee Relations Act," P.L. 1941, c.100 (C.34:13A-1 et seq.) and collective bargaining agreements entered into by the school district.

At the February 23, 2016, Board of Education meeting, the walk on resolution that served to "terminate the employment of Ms. Havana Berry" for conduct "determined to unacceptable and unbecoming..." received 4 yes votes and 3 abstentions, with two members absent for the vote. However, PBOE policy 0165-Voting states, in part, that majority of the full membership of the Board is required for removal of non-certificated staff members, per NJSA 18A:25-1, 27-1.

With regard to the vote, as well as to the personnel matter addressed in the resolution, the case and the resultant Board action each have been taken under review. First, Ms. Berry's engagement in the fight on September 14, 2015 has been established through witness accounts and legal investigations conducted by The Carroll Law Firm. Pursuant to 18A: 27-10.3 and PBOE policies 3143, 3150 and 4140, and based upon review of the case, the superintendent's recommendation to terminate the Ms. Berry is upheld.

Second, the Board did not act in accordance with Policy 0165, as there were 4 affirmative votes, not the majority of the full Board. Since November, action on the matter has been pending, most recently postponed due to the cancellation of the February 16 meeting when there was a lack of quorum. Any continuance of the matter is costly, for since the fight of September 14, Ms. Berry has continued on paid leave, at an annual salary of \$63,255. To avoid further delay in resolving this matter, and based upon the facts established through investigations, Ms. Berry is terminated effective February 24, 2015.

In closing, and as part of this determination, the Board is advised to participate in governance training so that members receive information necessary to conduct proper voting and to facilitate an effective meeting. Since many personnel matters are part of each month's agenda, including upcoming hiring, renewal, termination and/or reductions of force, this training is to be held as part of the next BOE meeting on March 16.
