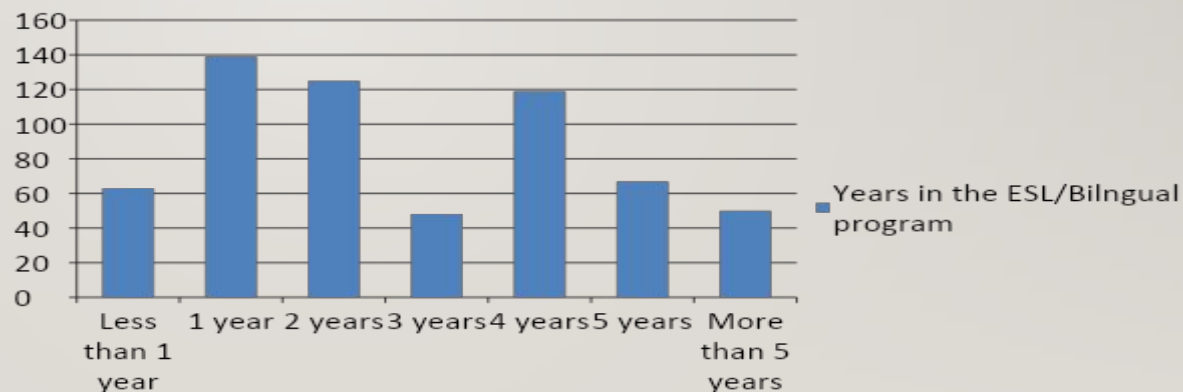

# STUDENT SAFETY DATA 2022-2023

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What is the Student Safety Data System (SSDS)?

The SSDS collects incidents of violence, vandalism, weapons, substance use, and harassment, intimidation and bullying (HIB), as well as HIB trainings and programs conducted to support anti-bullying efforts.

The incident types are as follows: • Arson • Assault • Computer Trespass • Damage to Property • False Public Alarm • Fight • HIB Alleged • HIB Confirmed • Kidnapping • Restraint • Robbery/Extortion • Seclusion • Sexual Assault • Sexual Contact • Substance Offense • Theft • Threat – Criminal • Threat – Simple • Trespass • Weapon Offense • Other Incident Leading to Removal

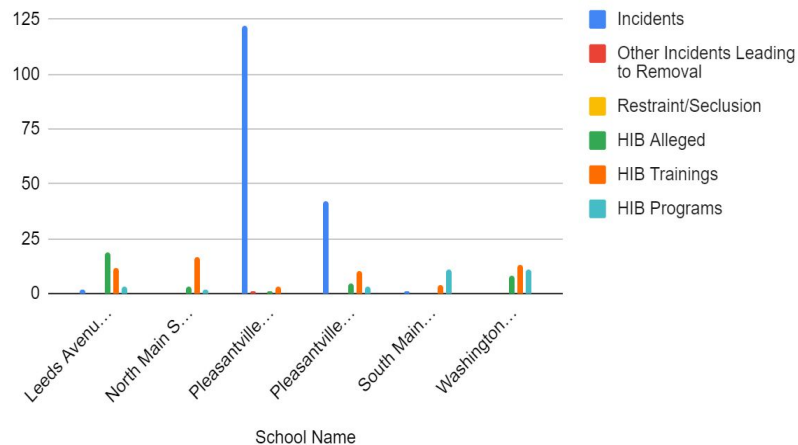
Special Consideration: A majority of our incidents at the secondary level are “substance possession” which includes vapes
