On April 14, 2021, a Boys Volleyball athlete notified us that he was experiencing COVID 19 symptoms. While we are unable to identify the affected athlete due to confidentiality requirements. The Atlantic County Department of Health will reach out to any player who has been identified as being in close contact with the affected individual (defined as within six feet for a prolonged period of time (even with a mask on) or direct contact with infectious secretions of a COVID-19 case (e.g. sneezed on).

To ensure your health and safety, we have taken steps to properly ensure the safety of all Boys Volleyball athletes in accordance with recommendations from the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the Atlantic County Department of Health. We encourage you to continue to practice social distancing, good hand sanitation, and monitor yourselves and your family for COVID-19 symptoms such as fever, cough, and shortness of breath. Symptoms of COVID-19 can appear 2-14 days after exposure. Please consult with your health care provider if symptoms develop. Thank you for your patience, understanding, and commitment as we work together to promote the health and well-being of our school community.
