Pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:16:-2.2(I), each school district shall ensure that all students are provided with the opportunity to receive health screenings conducted by a school physician, school nurse, or other personnel properly trained. The required screenings are outlined in the charts below:

Each School Nurse is available Monday through Thursday from 8:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. to screen your child(ren) by appointment in your designated school building. Your child will be screened in a safe atmosphere, adhering to all CDC guidelines for safety and cleanliness related to COVID-19. You may also provide the school with a current physical from your pediatrician with the required screenings.
