New Jersey Positive Behavior Support in Schools (PBSIS)



We are excited to announce the introduction of a new school climate initiative at Pleasantville High School. We have partnered with the New Jersey Positive Behavior Support in Schools (NJ PBSIS) initiative to design and implement school-wide interventions that will focus on promoting positive student behavior, improve our sense of community, and providing supports for students who need a little extra help. In collaboration with NJ PBSIS, we are looking forward to these positive changes in our school!

Through the NJ PBSIS initiative, we are learning about how to enhance our school's climate and atmosphere. In particular, we are focusing on how to:

1. Define what is expected of students.
2. Encourage consistent communication of expectations from staff to students.
3. Improve procedures and routines so the school day runs more smoothly.
4. Provide encouragement and social praise when students demonstrate the school expectations.
5. Make students feel welcomed and valued.
6. Foster positive interactions between students and between students and staff.
7. Provide students with help and support to overcome challenges and difficulties academically, socially, and behaviorally.
